IMPORTANT NOTES CONCERNING CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP

Applications for categories other than Family or Single membership must satisfy the Honorary Membership Secretary of their eligibility for the category of membership for which they are sought. Any decision of the Honorary Membership Secretary which is disputed by any applicant will be referred to the next available meeting of the Management Committee with any supporting evidence offered, for their decision.

As a guide for potential new members the Honorary Membership Secretary will apply the following criteria:-

- Family member* Person, partner and children under 19 years of age
- Student member* Person in full time education under 25 years of age
- Disabled member* Person to whom section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948 applies
- Pensioner member* Person who has attained State Pensionable age
- Pensioner family member* Person who has attained State Pensionable age and wants to sail with his family
- Country member* Person who permanently resides 100 miles or more from Club premises
- Assoc./Social member* Person who would wish to have access to all facilities offered by the Club other than those relating to the active participation in sailing.
- Junior (10-15)* Person who is under 16 years of age at the start of the subscription year. Category also permitting parent or guardian full access to club facilities, while junior member is participating in sailing/windsurfing activities and 2 hours post.
- Junior (16-18)* Person who is under 19 years of age at the start of the subscription year.
